

Jesus Christ Paid for my Sins

Colossians 2:13 ^(NIV) - *When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins...*

There is nothing left to do, Jesus did all that was needed. His work on the cross was complete, giving us total forgiveness. He forgave ALL our sins: past, present and future. The only thing left for us to do is to receive the gift of eternal life by faith.

Ephesians 2:8-9 ^(ESV) *For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.*

Galatians 2:16 ^(ESV) *Yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.*

Justification is when God declares righteous the person who believes what Christ did on the cross.

None of our good works save us. Faith in Christ as our Savior is enough to save us by His grace. That same grace allows us to live a life pleasing to God.

Receive Jesus Christ as Your Savior

John 1:12 ^(ESV) - *But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God...*

The Bible is clear that for us to have eternal life, all we have to do is BELIEVE in Jesus Christ and RECEIVE Him as Savior.

1 John 5:11-13 ^(ESV) *And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know that you have eternal life.*

My Sin Separates Me from God

Romans 3:23 (ESV) - *For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.*

"Fall short," means that in our own humanity we can't have a relationship with God. He is perfect and holy. The end result of our sins is death, not only physical death but also spiritual: an eternal separation from God in hell.
