

We must have the goal of forming at least 4 generations of disciples:

Paul → Timothy → Faithful Brother → Others

The command of Jesus Christ is of such an enormous nature, that we need to multiplying multipliers: disciples who will train others, who in turn will train others, so that these will train others as well. This should go on forever.

Key Verses: Matthew 28:18 - 20; 2 Timothy 2:2; 2 Peter 3:9.

Pray that our LORD Jesus Christ will help you remain faithful.

Who should I speak to?

Matthew 28:19 ^(ESV) - *Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit...*

Action Point: My network of relationships

- Make a list of all the people you know: family, friends, neighbors, fellow workers, classmates etc.
- Choose at least two people per week. Pray and decide to share the gospel with them. Seek to make this a lifetime habit.

Key Verses: Matthew 4:19; 1 Corinthians 9:16.

Pray that you can share the gospel to each person on the list and that they can receive Jesus Christ as Savior. Don't forget to pray before doing it!

How to begin?

1. Your personal salvation story

Having clarity of how you received Jesus Christ as Savior helps communicate your salvation story to others. You can use it as an introduction to the gospel. Write your story of how you received Jesus Christ and be able to share it in 2-3 minutes. Of course, if necessary, you can take more time.

Answering the following questions will help you create your own salvation story:

Before: Your life before receiving Christ

What had greater importance in your life?

What were your feelings, attitudes, actions, and relationships?

How: The moment of salvation

What was happening in your life when you heard the gospel?

When, where and who shared the gospel with you?

After: Your life after receiving Christ

How has your life begun to change after trusting Christ as Savior?

What benefits are you enjoying?

2. Gospel Presentation

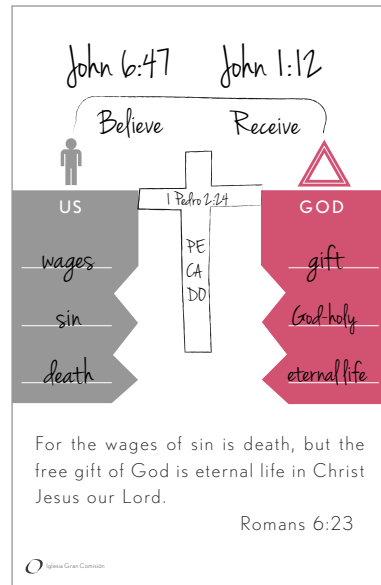
We must clearly share the message of salvation so that others can make the decision to receive Jesus Christ as their Savior. The Bridge is a means to share the gospel using the following diagram.
